

DOMINICAN UNIVERSITY POLICIES ON AP CREDITS

GENERAL CONDITIONS FOR AWARDING AP CREDIT:

1. There is no maximum of credit awarded through AP examination.
2. Students must have official scores sent to Dominican University. Refer to the College Board's website, <https://www.collegeboard.com>, for more information.
3. An AP score of 3 or above will earn general elective credit at DU, unless noted otherwise in the table below.
