



Tuition Remission Eligibility Waiver Request

Dependent children of Dominican University faculty and staff are eligible for tuition remission under the DU Tuition Remission Policy. The policy defines "dependent children" as under 26 years of age. However, the University recognizes that non-dependent children may find the need or have the desire to further their education, and therefore allows those individuals who fall outside the definition of "dependent children" to request that the eligibility requirement be waived so that they may receive full or partial tuition remission as part of their parent's university benefit. See policy for complete information. **NOTE:** Degree-seeking undergraduate students are still required to complete a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). Parents of graduate students will be subject to tax withholding.

In order to be considered for the waiver, please complete the following information and submit along with a copy of the letter indicating full acceptance into a DU academic program to the Director of Human Resources. Requests must be submitted **prior** to registration for the semester.
